

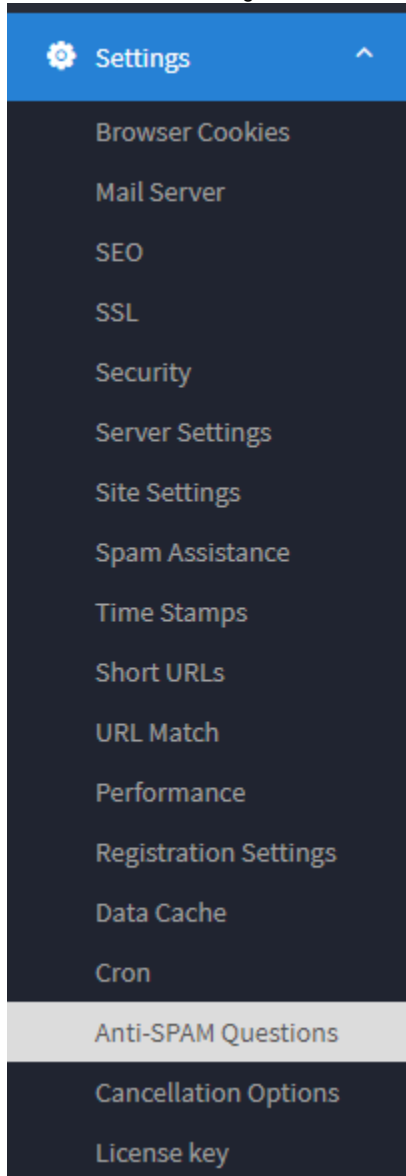
Enabling Anti-Spam Questions

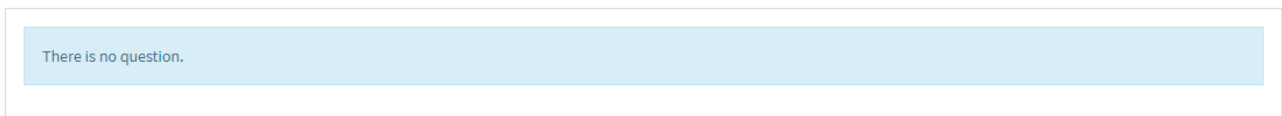
Fighting spammers is one of the tougher jobs of a website owner or administrator. One tool we provide, and that you should use if not using reCaptcha, is the Anti-Spam Questions with Images. You can google around for tips on making some but many site owners use their niche for ideas for the questions. This tutorial will show you how to enable and add anti-spam questions.

- In AdminCP, select Settings >> Anti-SPAM Questions



- Click Add New Question

- On the right, you'll see any questions you've already set up and to the right of that, you will see the input area to add more questions.

1. If you want an image with this, click to upload one from your computer.
2. Add your question here.
3. Add your answers. You might want to put a few variations of the answer such as with caps/without caps as some users might use caps and some might not. The "x" to the right of the answers is to delete that answer if needed.
4. Click the + to add more answers.
5. Click Add Question when done.
6. The "x" to the right of the answers is to delete that answer if needed.
