

# Enabling Anti-Spam Questions

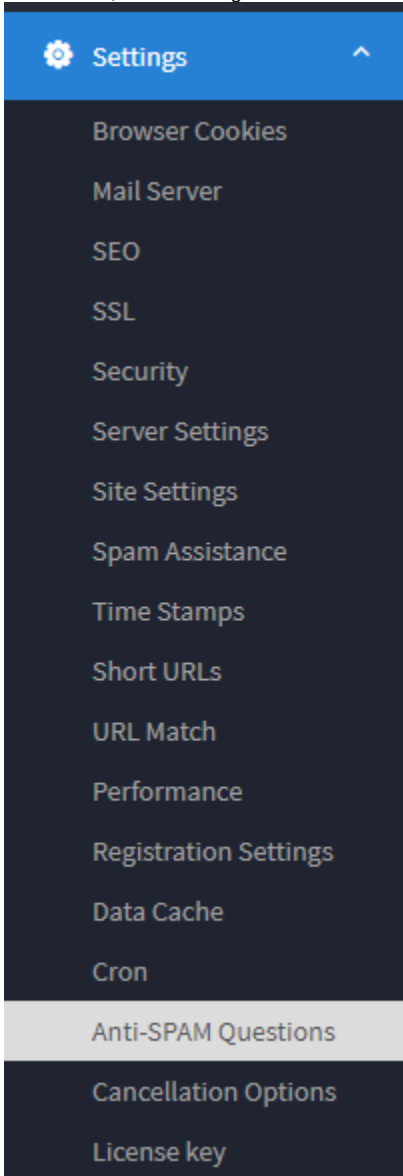
