Description

Core\Auth\User **auth()**

Using our **auth()** function will give you access to our core authentication class.

Examples

```

route('/foo', function() {

    // Check if a user is logged in
    if (auth()->isLoggedIn()) {
        echo "Hello logged in user!";
    }

    // Check if the user is an admin
    if (auth()->isAdmin()) {
        echo "Hello Admin!";
    }

});

route('/bar', function() {

    // This will redirect the user if they are not logged in
    auth()->membersOnly();

});
```

Methods

Method	Description	Usage	Returns
isLoggedIn()	Check if a user is logged in or not.	<pre>if (auth()->isLoggedIn()) { echo "Hello logged in user!"; }</pre>	true if logged in, false if not
membersOnly()	Redirect a user to the login page if they are not logged in.	<pre>route('/bar', function() { // This will redirect the user if they are not // logged in auth()->membersOnly(); });</pre>	null
isAdmin()	Checks to see if a user is a site Admin	<pre>if (auth()->isAdmin()) { echo "Hello Admin!"; }</pre>	true if logged in, false if not
