## Description

Core\Moment **moment**( [int [\\$seconds](#)] )

Provides methods that are part of our cores Moment class that deals with time related functions.

## Parameters

[\\$seconds](#)

Shorthand call to toString() method, which converts UNIX time to human readable time stamps.

## Examples

```

route('/foo', function() {

    // Prints the current UNIX time stamp
    $time = moment()->now();

    echo $time;

    // Converts a UNIX time stamp to human readable time (e.g 1 second ago)
    echo moment()->toString($time);

    /**
     * Short hand of the toString() method
     */
    echo moment($time);

});
```

## Methods

Method	Description	Usage	Returns
now()	Get the current UNIX time stamp.	<pre>echo moment()-&gt;now();  // You can shorthand it as well echo moment();</pre>	Returns current UNIX time stamp.
toString(int <a href="#">\$seconds</a> )  <a href="#">\$seconds</a>  UNIX time stamp	Converts a UNIX time stamp to human readable time (e.g 1 second ago)	<pre>\$time = moment()-&gt;now();  echo moment()-&gt;toString(\$time);  /**  * Short hand of the toString() method  */ echo moment(\$time);</pre>	Examples based on time stamp... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ 1 seconds ago</li><li>▪ about 4 hours ago</li><li>▪ 3 days ago</li><li>▪ January 15, 2015</li></ul>
