Setup the default time zone for your site to avoid confusion while tracking actions. This article will guide you how to configure TimeZone and Time Format on your phpFox site. We assume that you already [log in AdminCP](#). Here are next steps:

- On Side Menu in AdminCP, go to **Settings >> Time Stamps**

### Time Stamps

**Default Time Zone**

Africa/Abidjan

Select the default time zone for guests and new users.

**Global Time Stamp**

Each module has items that are displayed and use our time stamp settings to display the date the way we would like.

If a module does not specify a time stamp setting it will use the default time stamp layout which is controlled with this setting.
