

# Managing Apps

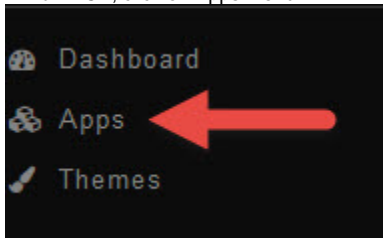
This tutorial will show you how to manage Apps for your website. This assumes you are already logged in as the Admin user and are [logged into the AdminCP](#).












Requires:

- **phpFox 4.5+**

In AdminCP, click on Apps menu.



The Management Page is something like this:

- This pages will list all installed apps on your site (both Core apps and Third-party apps)
- **VERSION**: current version of the app on your site
- **LATEST**: the latest version of the app that published on the [store](#). A link for the upgrade will be shown if the current version of the app on your site is smaller than the latest version.
- **AUTHOR**: developer/company who published this app.
- **ACTIVE**: toggle button to enable/disable the app.
