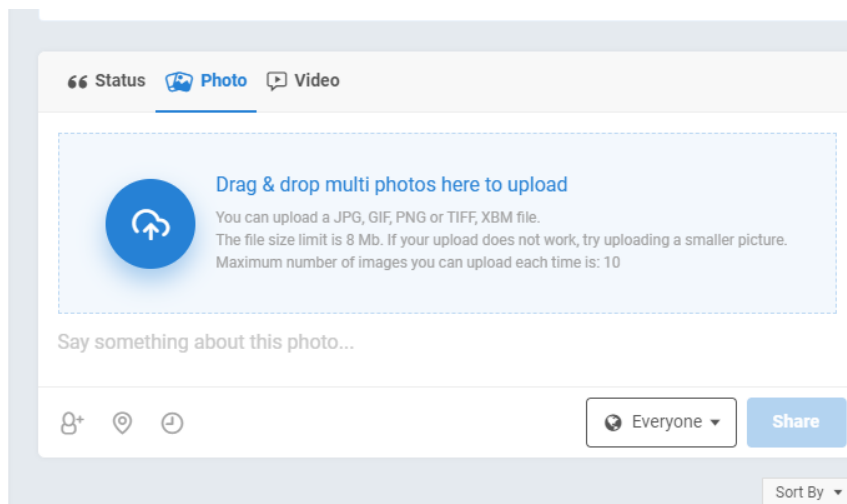


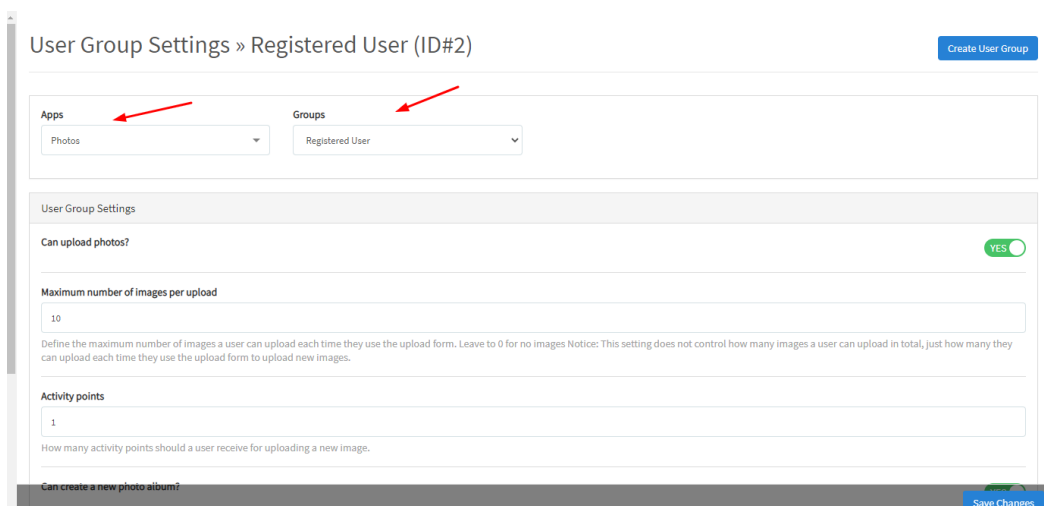
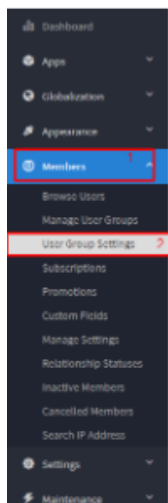
How to increase photo size upload in phpFox?

In this article, we are going to walk you through changing the photo size upload in phpFox. Let's start!



Here are all the steps on how to increase the photo size upload in phpFox

First, you need to login to your site as an **Admin**, then from **Members> User Group Settings>Choose Apps is Photos** and **Groups is a specific user group that you would like to increase the photo size upload**. For example, the selected user group is **Registered User**.



Next, please search for the setting **"Max file size for photos upload"** and change the current value by any value you want>**Save Changes** to apply the new one.
